MOLLET CLUB ELECTIONS

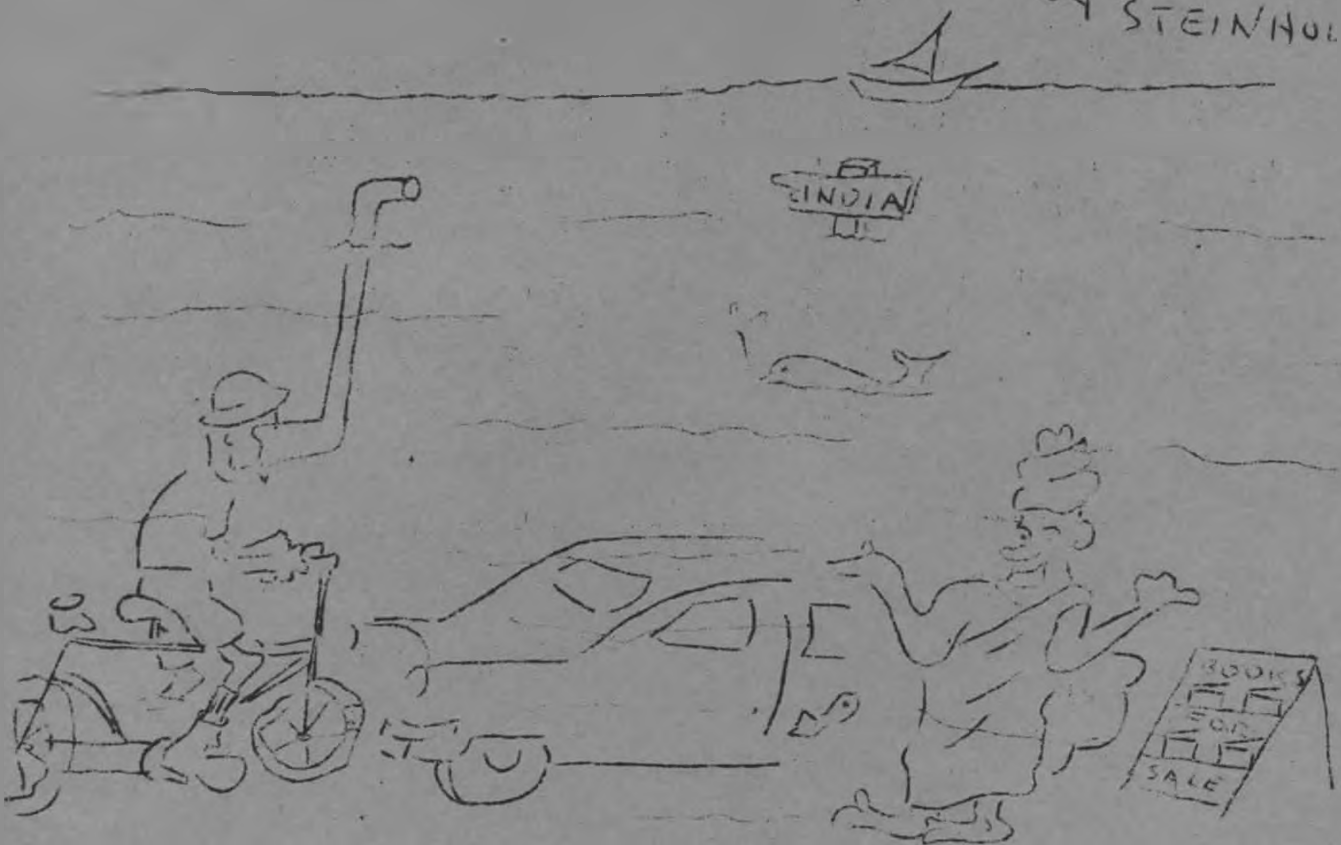
At a recent "Mollet Club meeting", held under the rigid rules of parliamentary procedure, the following officers were elected for the coming year:
