

# Executive Summary for F. Franklin Moon Library

2015-2016 Annual Report

We reached **1,261 learners** through guest lectures, workshops, and other life-long learning opportunities.

Our credit bearing courses, ESF 200 and ESF 797, **enrolled 303 students**, including 14 graduate students.

The Friends of Moon Library helped to raise over \$10,000 to **support the college archives and library initiatives**. The Friends are celebrating their 30 year anniversary in 2016.

We offered new, self-sustaining services, such as the **Passport Acceptance Facility**, to support our campus community and the broader community.

We are comprehensively inventorying our collection to **facilitate access, discovery, and sharing** of our print collection.

We **employed 17 student workers** and provided opportunities for **volunteers** to learn about the library and contribute to our mission.

We **supported strategic campus initiatives** through building digital collections for the Roosevelt Wild Life Station, Fletcher Steele, and faculty and student work. The collections benefit our community and the broadest, global community.

We engage with the **Academic Governance Library Advisory Committee** for counsel on leveraging our limited financial resources to best serve our campus community's information needs.

Library faculty and staff provide many hours of service to **improve, enhance, and engage our community**.

Library employees reached out to students, faculty, staff, alumni, friends, and others to **enhance awareness of our services, facilities, and resources**.

We house and support the new Scantron to serve the **teaching needs of our faculty**.

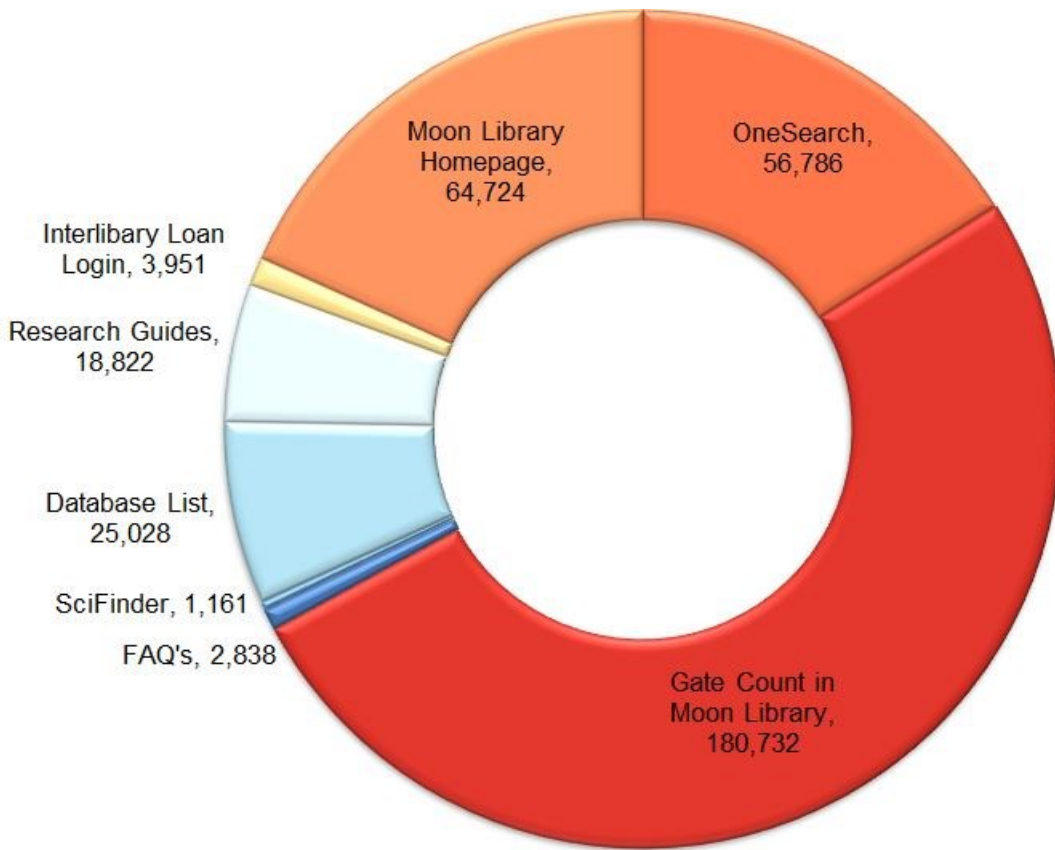

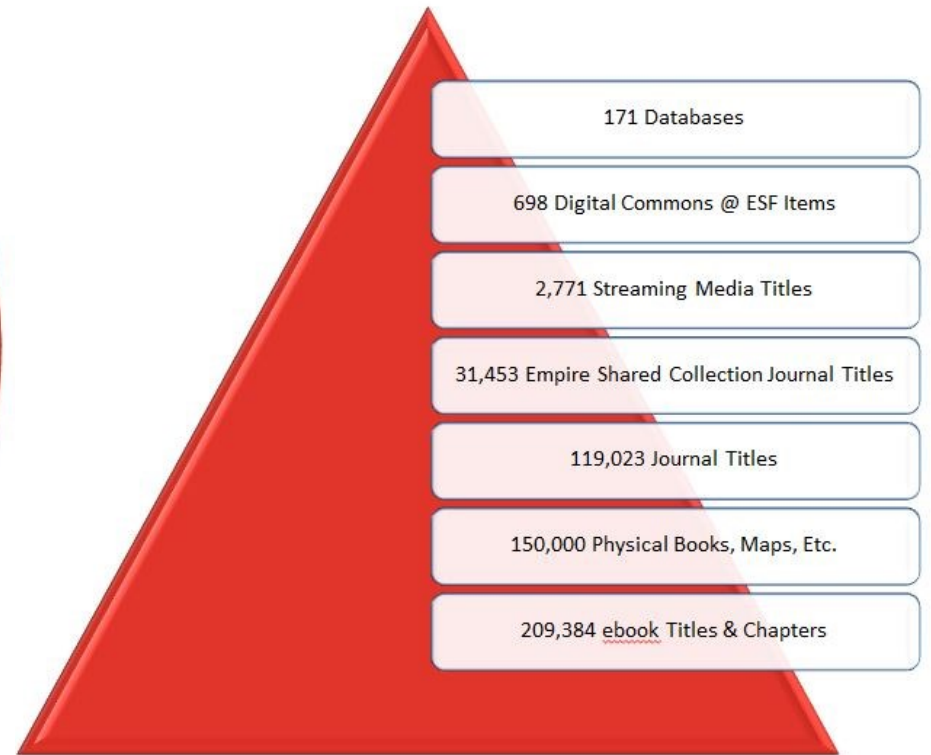

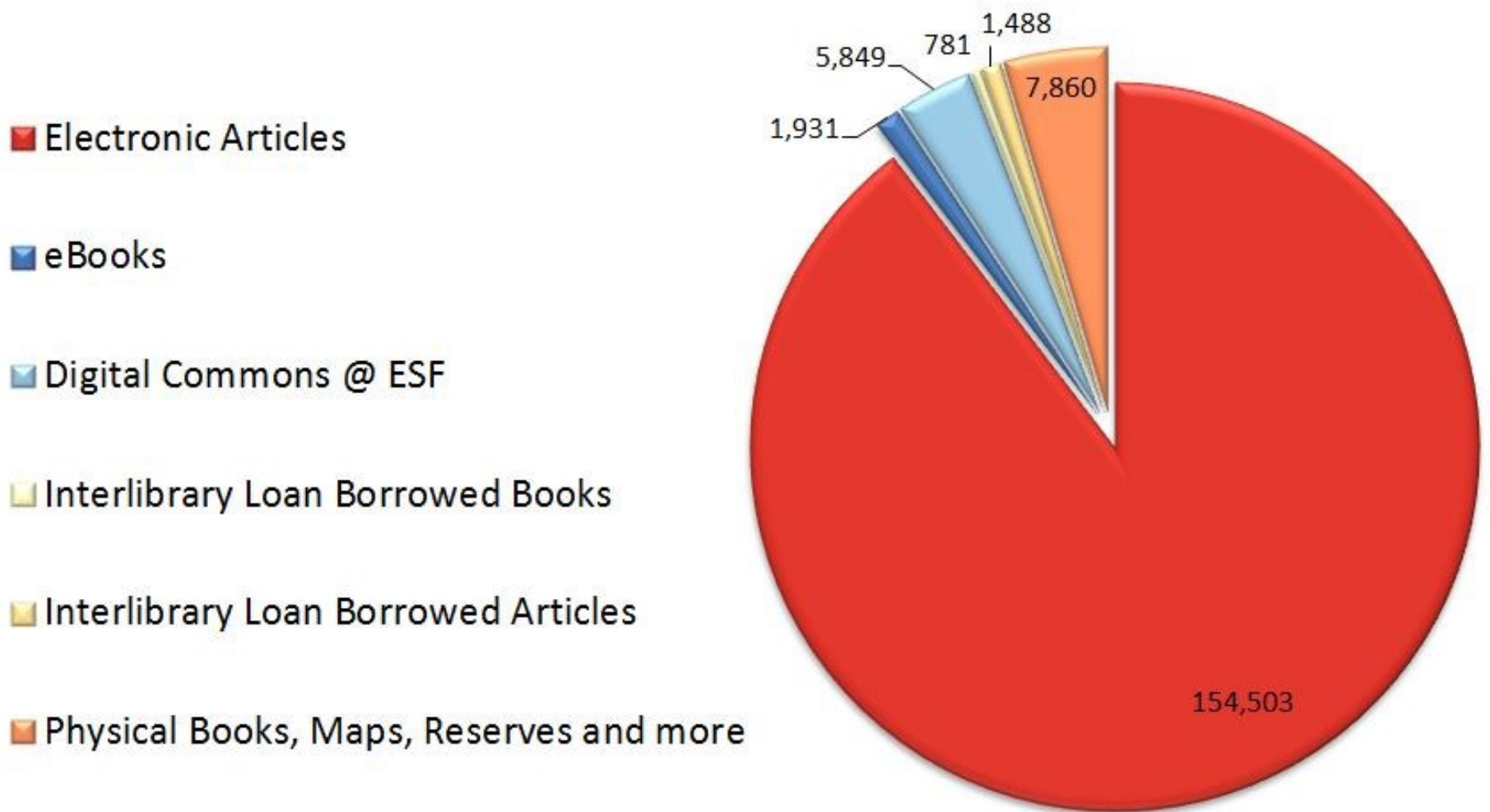
